Agreement between Manchester Chinese Centre and Youth Ambassadors

- I will obey the Chinese laws and legal system. This includes:
 - no consuming of alcohol if under the age of 18 years
 - no buying of alcohol for anyone younger than 18 years
 - drink sensibly and responsibly, do not get out of control
 - no taking of illegal drugs/ illegal substances
 - no damaging public facilities and premises
 - please refrain from blatantly discussing politically sensitive topics
- I will dress sensibly, ie. Not too revealing
- I will respect the rules and system of the Chinese summer camp
- I respect that males and females are in separate hotel rooms for obvious reasons
- I understand that I need to do consistent voluntary work in exchange for accommodation and food
- My duty is to represent British youths and influence and help Chinese youths develop a new concept and idea of the English lifestyle
- I have to read the health and safety booklet before I set off
- I have my travel insurance and passport
- I understand the importance of my behaviour and manner as a youth ambassador
- I understand that I need to write a personal diary that expresses myself and my honest point of view of each day of the trip
- I need to complete and type up my diary by 1st September and hand it into MCC (this will be displayed by the end of September)

NB: China adopts a Capital Punishment system

- Tap water in China cannot be directly consumed, drink bottled water instead
- Make sure you bring medication from UK if you will be needing it during the trip

(By October, each youth Ambassador will get a certificate to verify that they took part on this trip)
